Symbol, function and beauty, controlling values in internal design and furniture in holy Mecca

Abstract;

God blessed Mecca with the honor of having the first house of god and the only mosque to do Haj or Umrahrituals and the quest between the 2 mountains Al-Safa and Al-Marwa.
