Summary:

The modern art with its directions and schools especially the abstract expressionism, with its content from aesthetical values, can be an important resource for creation in the field of science in general and specially in textile printing field.

The Computer in the field of designing textiles printing has an important role in creating new styles to use the abstract expressionism in designing weaved textile hangings printed by computers in programming the aesthetical and constructional potentials in the design process to create an innovative designs that are characterized with accurate, fast and diverse results.

This study concentrates on identification of the aesthetic spots in the abstract forms and tries to use them by the aid of computer in new ways to suit their functional purposes.
