#### **Abstract:**

The art of mandala is one of the Indian heritage arts, which has witnessed a wide spread and an evolution in its forms nowadays. Recently, many models have emerged for the possibility of combining mandala units with interior design and furniture. Although the shapes and colors of mandalas may differ according to the usage type and the way they are blended in.
