2. Research Problem.

5. Research Terms.

Internal space: It is the three-dimensional space (length, width, height) in which the interior design process takes place based on its functional and aesthetic purpose.

Globalization: "It is all the new developments and advancements that seek, intentionally or unintentionally, to integrate the world's population into one global community." (Malcom Waters 2007)

6. Research methodology.

The researcher relied on the analytical approach, where an applied case of the home of a Palestinian ambassador in Italy was analyzed as a model, in which the determinants of the Palestinian cultural identity integrated into the interior design were analyzed and how it is reflected in the residential environment. As well as the inductive approach to reach the correct knowledge by extrapolating all information from the study of the cultural identity of Palestine and Italy, the study of the historical architecture of Palestine and Italy, the study of the elements of interior design of Palestinian and Italian culture and applying the results to the case Application for the Palestinian Ambassador's House in Italy.

Research results:

5. The psychological impact of colors on humans is linked to customs, traditions, and the cultural and social stock rooted in society.

Research recommendations:

1. The interior designer should benefit from previous scientific experiences and be informed about the latest technologies, materials, artistic and intellectual trends, and employ them in a way that serves civilization, identity and culture.

2. Developing the national sense of community members through intellectual enrichment in interior design with cultural identity.
3. Translating the Palestinian cultural identity into design vocabulary and elements, and the interior designer should link these elements to interior design to find ways to express that identity.

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
